

Absentee Voting for April 3, 2012 General Municipal

Absentee ballots for the April 3, 2012 General Municipal Election will be available to eligible voters as of February 21st. Missouri election law allows that registered voters may apply for an absentee ballot for the following reasons: (1) absence from the county on election day; (2) incapacity or confinement due to illness or physical disability; (3) acting as a caregiver for a person who is confined due to illness or physical disability; (4) religious belief or practice; (5) employment as an election official; or (6) incarceration, though must have retained all necessary qualifications for voting.

Eligible voters may cast an absentee ballot at the Platte County Board of Election Commissioners office in Platte City, 2600 NW Prairie View Rd. The office is open for absentee voting Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. through April 2nd, the day before the election. In addition, the Election Board office will offer extended hours for absentee voting on Saturday, March 31, 2012, 8 a.m. – 12 p.m. (noon).

Absentee Ballots may also be mailed to eligible voters, after submitting a signed request stating the reason for voting by absentee ballot. An absentee ballot application form may be printed from this webpage. Voters may fax the signed application to the Board of Elections at (816) 858-3387 or mail to Platte County Board of Elections, PO Box 560, Platte City MO 64079. The last day to request an absentee ballot to be mailed to the voter is March 28, 2012.
