Construction Priority: Third



This 4.24 mile corridor is comprised of two segments. Segment one is a .64 mile, hard surface, off-road, shared use trail which runs from JJ Highway on the west and transitions at McKee Road into segment two, a 3.6 mile, hard surface, on-road, improved shoulder which passes Cooley Lake Wildlife Area on its way to the Clay/Ray County Line.
