

# Hwy. 291/Mosby via Fishing River

Construction Priority: Second



This 12.28 mile off-road, soft surface stream corridor is for equestrian use and connects the town of Mosby to Highway 291. With agricultural land on both banks, the user will experience wooded riparian vegetation and several creek crossings along the Fishing River route. Closer to the terminus of the route, the woodland canopy opens up and the Fishing River Greenway and forested canopy areas transition to open graze land.
