

Wolcott/Line Creek via Hwy. 45

Construction Priority: Second



This 10.68 mile shared use route is on a hard surface, off-road trail and connects flood plain areas with urban development. Beginning at the intersection of 45 and FF Highways, this route becomes more challenging as the user leaves the flat flood plains and enters into rolling terrain. Scenic and steep terrain exist near Tom Watson's "The National" Golf Course, but users of various skill levels are rewarded with a milder trail segment nearing Riss Lake. At I-29, users may turn north or south on other trails.
