

Clay/Platte County Line - Weston



Construction Priority: First/Third

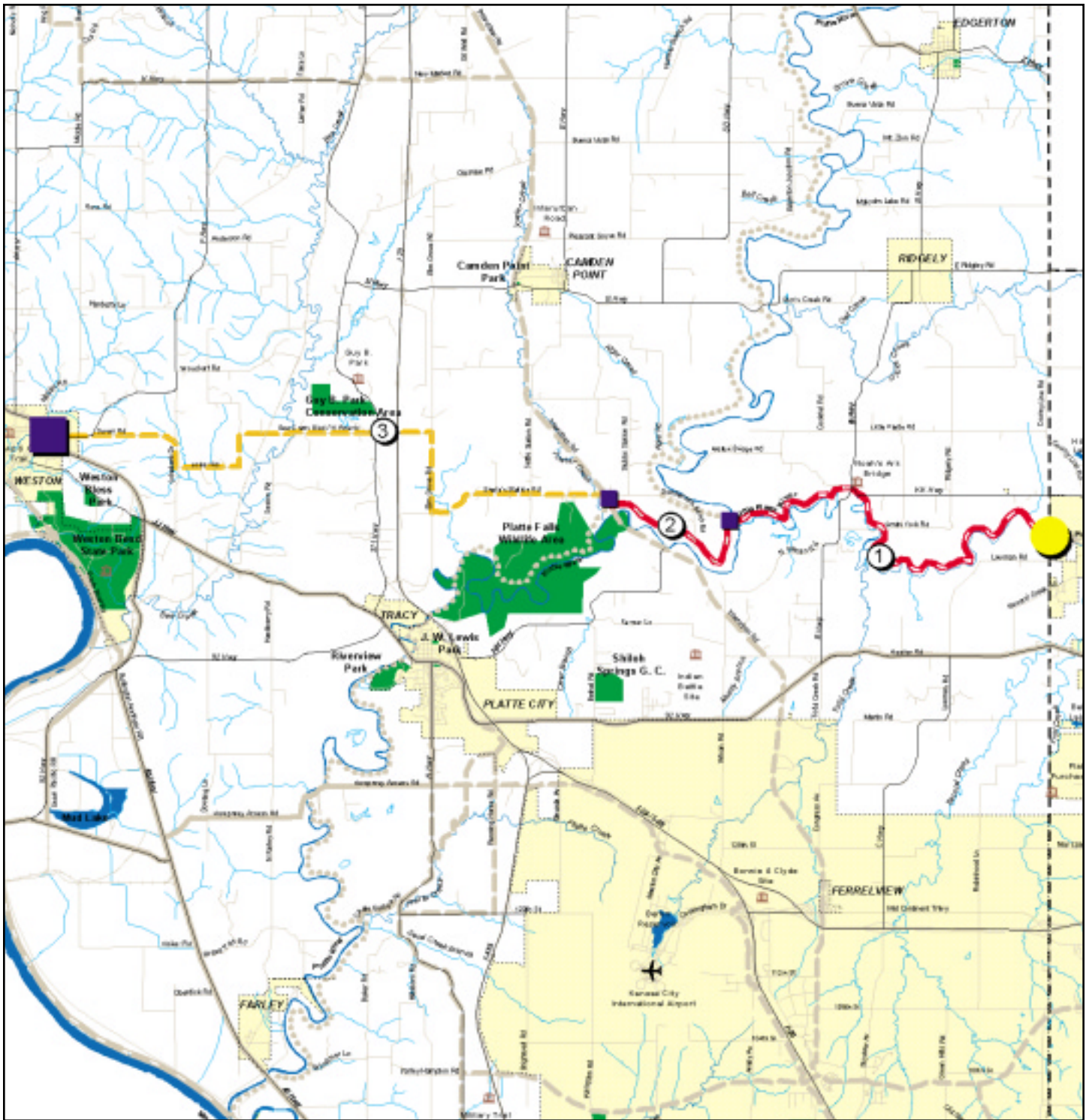
This 21.73-mile route features segments for shared use and equestrian use. shared use will be off-road, hard surface, while a separate off-road, soft surface for equestrian users will be provided. The trail runs from Weston and Highway 45, with easy connections to historic Weston, Weston Bend State Park and Weston Bless Park, to the Platte/Clay County Line. As the trail goes east from

Weston, it will parallel Bee Creek Road, Sharp's Station Road, cross the Platte River, and Noah's Ark Bridge Historic Site as it moves toward the county line. Steep hills, wildlife and stream crossings make this segment suitable for intermediate to expert trail users.
